2 SAFETY CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT/MEDICAL PROCEDURES

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4 A. Whenever a unit member is attacked, assaulted, or menaced by a pupil, it shall  
5 be the duty of that member, and the duty of any person under whose direction or supervision  
6 such unit member is assigned in the District who has knowledge of the incident, to promptly  
7 report the incident to the appropriate law enforcement authorities of the county or city in  
8 which the incident occurred.

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10 B. Unit members may use reasonable lawful force under the circumstances in  
11 order to defend themselves against an assault or battery which occurs within the scope of  
12 employment. The unit member shall report in writing any such incident to the immediate  
13 supervisor within a 24-hour period. The immediate supervisor shall provide the unit member  
14 periodic reports of any corrective action taken to remedy the circumstances surrounding the  
15 incident.

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17 C. The District has not and does not require unit members to perform medical  
18 procedures, toileting, and/or pushing of wheelchairs of students.

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20 D. Unit members shall not be asked, but may choose to volunteer to be trained to  
21 perform medical procedures on students, toileting, and/or pushing wheelchairs. The unit  
22 member who performs such tasks does so without setting precedent or causing prejudice to  
23 future negotiations.

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
